Dear Parents/Carers,

We have had multiple positive COVID-19 cases reported over the past week

If your child develops symptoms such as a fever, cough, sore throat, shortness of breath, runny nose, loss of smell/taste, muscle/joint pains, diarrhoea, nausea/vomiting or extreme tiredness, they should get tested and stay at home until they are well.

IF A STUDENT OR STAFF MEMBER TESTS POSITIVE FOR COVID-19 THEY MUST NOTIFY THE SCHOOL AND/OR OSHC. PLEASE DO NOT ATTEND FOR 5 DAYS IF COVID-19 POSITIVE. DO NOT ATTEND WHILE SYMPTOMATIC

It is recommended positive COVID-19 cases stay home until acute symptoms have cleared and take steps to protect others. Siblings of confirmed positive cases are considered a close contact and should follow the advice from <u>SA Health</u>.

The safety and wellbeing of our children/students and staff are paramount. As such, we will continue to work closely with SA Health to ensure that all necessary health advice is closely followed, and all necessary precautions are taken to minimise the risk of further transmission within our community.

We will continue to provide regular updates of positive COVID-19 cases in our North Ingle School and Preschool/OSHC.
